



# CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

## 2018 FIRST DIVISION PAVING PROJECT MAY 8, 2018

On behalf of the Village of Riverside, it is our pleasure to inform you that the 2018 First Division Paving Project is scheduled to **begin on Friday, May 11, 2018**. The scheduled work will involve the resurfacing of roadways, drainage structure repairs (where necessary), new curb and gutter (where necessary), new ADA compliant sidewalk ramps, and new sidewalk (as necessary). In areas in which new curb and gutter are being installed, the adjacent area may also be replaced. This includes courtesy walks, driveway aprons and/or sod. The following streets are to be resurfaced as part of the Project:

**Scottswood Rd.** (from Barry Point Rd. to Fairbank Rd.)  
**Millbridge Rd.** (from Fairbank Rd. to Bloomingbank Rd.)  
**Coonley Rd.** (from Fairbank Rd. to Bloomingbank Rd.)  
**Fairbank Rd.** (from Barry Point Rd. to Bloomingbank Rd.)  
**Bloomingbank Rd.** (from Fairbank Rd. to Barry Point Rd.)

Access to driveways will be available throughout the duration of the project except for if/when your driveway apron or curb in front of your driveway apron is replaced. If this applies to you, a notification will be delivered the day before removals are scheduled with additional information.

If you have a sprinkler system in your front parkway, we ask that you clearly mark the location of these sprinklers, so that we can make precautions to avoid unnecessary damage. Please note that per Village code, the property owner is required to provide the Village with a liability waiver which absolves the Village of repair responsibility for damage from projects involving the parkway. The Village also has no repair responsibility for sprinkler systems installed without provision of the liability waiver; therefore, any damage made to parkway sprinklers will be the owner's responsibility to repair.

Throughout the duration of the project, on-street parking will be limited and NO PARKING signs will be installed when required. Please adhere to any NO PARKING signs that are posted within the limits of the project as well as permanent parking restrictions. If vehicles are parked where NO PARKING signs have been posted, vehicles will be towed, if necessary.

The anticipated completion date for the project is July 6, 2018.
