## Riverside Police Officers Honored for DUI Enforcement Efforts

Four Riverside Police Officers were recently recognized by the Alliance Against Intoxicated Motorists for their work in removing impaired drivers from Riverside roadways in 2017. Officers **Brian Greenenwald**, **Joseph Mahanna**, **Isaac Hamilton** and **Chris Kudla** each received a certificate of appreciation this month after combining for 96 total arrests for driving under the influence last year.
