Riverside Police Department is seeking candidates interested in a rewarding law enforcement career. A competitive, written exam will be held Saturday, May 9, 2020.

- No felony convictions
- Submit online application and all supporting documentation by Thursday, April 9, 2020 at 4:00 p.m.

## Orientation and Testing Information:

Candidates must attend the mandatory orientation and written examination on **Saturday, May 9, 2020**. Test will be held at Riverside-Brookfield High School, 160 Ridgewood Road, Riverside, IL. Doors will open at 8:00 a.m. and you must arrive before **8:30** a.m. There will be no admission after 8:30 a.m. Additional details regarding testing details will be provided to eligible candidates via email approximately one week before the exam date.
