**III. Acknowledgement of Publication of Public Hearing Notice
Public Works Director Dan Tabb**

Director Tabb acknowledged that the public notice was published in the Riverside-Brookfield Landmark on September 6, 2023.

IV. Village of Riverside Lead Service Line and Water Main Replacement Project

Village Engineer Orion Galey provided an overview of the project, stating that Riverside is in the process of applying for Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) Public Water Supply Loan Program (PWSLP) funding for the Water Main and Lead Service Replacement Project. The water main project consists of replacing 19,112 linear feet of four-inch diameter water main over four phases. The lead service project consists of replacing 500 lead service lines per year over a five-year period. The project seeks to replace lead water lines in the Village as lead is a toxic metal with well documented adverse health effects. The project also seeks to replace antiquated and small water mains throughout the Village to reduce the number of water main breaks. The Village is requesting to finance \$20,000,000 for lead service replacements and \$8,558,528 for water main replacements with loans from the IEPA.
