



**Public Hearing  
Proposed 2022 Tax Levy  
Village of Riverside and Riverside Public Library**

**Minutes**

- I. **Call to Order:** The Public Hearing for the Proposed 2022 Tax Levy for the Village of Riverside and Riverside Public Library was held in Room 4 of the Riverside Township Hall, 27 Riverside Road, Riverside, IL, on Thursday, October 20, 2022. President Ballerine called the Public Hearing to order at 7:00 p.m.

- III. **Acknowledgement of Publication of Public Hearing Notice**

Finance Director Johns stated that the estimates of the 2022 property tax levies were announced, pursuant to state law, at the October 6, 2022 Board of Trustees meeting and the notice announcing the date of the 2022 tax levy public hearing was published in the Landmark newspaper on October 12, 2022.
  
- IV. **2022 Tax Levy Presentation – Village of Riverside and Riverside Public Library**

Finance Director Johns stated that the corporate and special purpose property tax levies estimated to be extended or abated for 2021 are \$6,857,564. The

estimated 2022 taxes levied for those purposes are \$7,419,865, which represents an 8.2% increase over the previous year. The property tax estimated to be extended for debt service and public building commission leases in 2021 are \$762,197. The estimated 2022 taxes levied for those purposes are \$729,728, which represents a 4.26% decrease over the previous year. The total net property tax levy to be extended or abated in 2021 for the Village and Library is \$7,619,761. The estimate expected to be levied and abated in 2022 is \$8,149,592, which represents a 6.95% increase over the previous year.

Director Johns stated that this year’s Consumer Price Index (CPI) is 7%; however, property taxes for non-home municipalities are capped at a 5% increase. Cook County will ensure that the Village’s levy is cut off at the amount of new property, which is estimated at 5%.
