

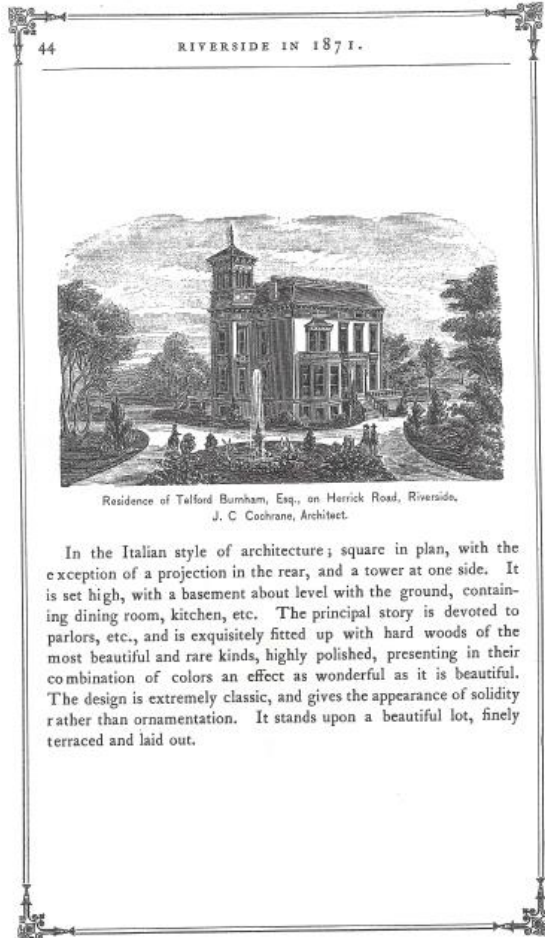

Riverside News – Series called “Yesterday of Riverside”

August 27, 1920 by A.C. Dyrenforth, Local Editor
“Mr. Burnham, a lawyer, a brother of Daniel Burnham, a notable architect, built a very expensive home on Herrick Road. The architecture was that of an Italian Villa. The interior finish was in inlaid woods, some being beautiful. Mrs. Burnham sang very well and Riverside friends were sorry to see them go after but a few years when they sold their home to Charles Coryell, who was a brother to Mrs. W. T. Allen and lived but a short time to enjoy his new home. Mrs. Coryell sold to E.A. Driver in 1878, who was an enthusiastic lover of everything beautiful and with his family, continued to beautify his home until after his death his widow made el Montecilo, Cal., her permanent home, selling the Riverside property to Frank Story, who did extensive remodeling and modernizing only to be burned out in a short time.
