## Available Volunteer Projects

### Fall & Spring:

- Grow Swamp and Common Milkweed from seed or small stock to plug form.
- Planting more Milkweed in Riverside (Public and Private locations)
- Capture Monarch eggs and develop them into caterpillars, pupa and release adult Monarchs back to nature (only 1% of eggs in nature make it to the adult stage)
- Promote and distribute non-spraying methods for Mosquitoes (Mosquito Dunk Tanks)

### Pollinator Expansion –Spring Ephemerals & More – Fall & Spring

- Grow from seed to plug size plant materials
- Grow from small stock to plug size plant materials
- Plant stock in specified Triangles within Riverside to promote native pollinators
- Distribute plant materials at Riverside Farmer's Market in Spring with LAC to private homeowners

### Triangle Adoption

- Adopt a Triangle in Riverside –Work w LAC on Project
- Clear out invasive species
- LAC to support funding and asking key organizations for plant material financial support
- Plan a native plant planting to replace invasive plant material
- Water triangle for 1<sup>st</sup> growing season (LAC & Public Works support of hydrant access)
- Planning in Fall-Spring Installation – Summer Watering

### Invasive Tree/bush “Trade In” with Riverside Residences

- Identify an invasive tree/bush on their property (List and photos provide by LAC)
- Resident to take a photo of its removal
- Apply for a native tree replacement with photo and form to Ecology Club
- LAC to support by asking key organizations for plant material financial support (Riverside Township, Possibility Place, Grants Etc.)
- Fall to Spring depending on Funding

### Miscellaneous

- Clear out Olmsted Overlook Area
- Help residents with their native plantings
